







Figure 2: In week 17-2024, ILI has the upper trend with 1141 case followed by acute diarrhea (non-cholera) 376 cases.










Figure 3: There is decrease in number of AD (non-Cholera) & in ILI cases week 17-2024.

Expanded Program on Immunization activities of Health Department ICT

EPI in Pakistan is coordinated at Federal Directorate of Immunization under the Ministry of National Health Services and Regulation Coordination (NHSR&C). The EPI program shall be including vaccines for prevention of vaccine preventable diseases among the adolescents and older age groups as the evidence of vaccines' effectiveness is acquired and advised by the NITAG. The immunization schedule shall thus be periodically updated as and when required depending upon the local disease burden and requirements. The health department with an objective to improve the health of all works on prevention of the diseases EPI is one of the major components. The EPI at district level is managed and supported by staff at district level and the EPI services are provided at Union council level through Fixed Centers, Outreach Vaccination sites and mobile if applicable.




Figure 4: In week 17-2024, total coverage vaccine wise. BCG 345, Penta I 578, Penta II 536, Penta III 538, MR I 505, MR II 563, TD-I 105, TD-II 119, TD-III 18 and TD-IV-V 7.






Figure 5: In week 17-2024, Total static coverage was 1719, Outreach total was 1531, Zero dose covered were 209, and defaulter covered were 350.




Figure 6: There is vaccine coverage of Public private partnership with private hospitals. In week 17-2024 a total of 766 doses of different antigen were given by hospitals in private sector.







Mobile Service Unit Activities of Health Department ICT

The health department with an objective to improve the health of all, free medical camps are routine activity to provide preventive and curative health services to far rural areas in Islamabad. Two medical camps were held in rural area this week at Bhimber Tarar & Madina Town Tarlai.

MSU Camp at Chirrah on 25-04-2024

- 1. 114 patients were examined and given treatment.
- 2. 76 clients were accessed for FP services.
- 3. 06 Lab tests performed
- 4. 40 children received routine immunization vaccinations.









MSU Camp at Farash Town -Ali Pur

- 1. 144 patients were examined and given treatment.
- 2. 68 clients were accessed for FP services.
- 3. 8 Lab tests performed
- 4. 18 children received routine immunization vaccinations.
