


Figure 1: In week 36-2024, disease trends of ILI and acute diarrhea (non-cholera).




Figure 2: In week 36-2024, ILI has the upper trend with 1195 cases followed by acute diarrhea (non-cholera) 393 cases.










Figure 3: There is decrease in number of AD (non-Cholera) & increase in ILI cases week 36-2024.

Expanded Program on Immunization activities of Health Department ICT

EPI in Pakistan is coordinated at Federal Directorate of Immunization under the Ministry of National Health Services and Regulation Coordination (NHSR&C). The EPI program shall be including vaccines for prevention of vaccine preventable diseases among the adolescents and older age groups as the evidence of vaccines' effectiveness is acquired and advised by the NITAG. The immunization schedule shall thus be periodically updated as and when required depending upon the local disease burden and requirements. The health department with an objective to improve the health of all works on prevention of the diseases EPI is one of the major components. The EPI at district level is managed and supported by staff at district level and the EPI services are provided at Union council level through Fixed Centers, Outreach Vaccination sites and mobile if applicable.




Figure 4: In week 36-2024, total coverage vaccine wise. BCG 318, Penta I 362, Penta II 365, Penta III 361, MR I 337, MR II 296, TD-I 178, TD-II 131, TD-III 16 and TD-IV-V 06.










Figure 5: In week 36-2024, Total static coverage was 1410, Outreach total was 890 Zero dose covered were 224, and defaulter covered were 319.




Figure 6: There is vaccine coverage of Public private partnership with private hospitals. In week 36-2024 a total of 326 doses of different antigen were given by hospitals in private sector.








